### CHURCH COUNCIL REPORT

At its meeting on 12<sup>th</sup> February, Church Council:

- \* received a report from the Strategy Committee, including recommendations to:
- o start a Youth Group
- o review arrangements for pastoral care
- o host or hold an event in Senior's Week and Children's Week
- o establish a fundraising program to refurbish the pews in the church by the end of 2021

o replace the heating system in the church with a split-cycle system o review the terms of reference for all committees of Church Council o develop a 12-month schedule of activities to assist with planning and advertising

- \* determined that a Service of Severing Pastoral Ties to mark the conclusion of Ps Geoff Aitken's ministry at Belmont UC be held on Sunday, 30 June.
- \* endorsed and adopted Synod Safe Church documents, including the Keeping Children Safe Policy, the Responding to and Reporting Child Abuse Procedure, the Statement of Commitment and the Keeping Children Safe Code of Conduct
- \* requested the Safe Church Committee to ensure that all members of the congregation engaged in child-related ministry or activities on behalf of the congregation receive and sign a copy of the Keeping Children Safe Code of Conduct
- \* noted that the Playgroup has ceased to operate
- \* congratulated Welcome Mat on its 20th Anniversary
- \* congratulated the Kindergarten on its 60th Anniversary
- \* appointed office bearers and Committee convenors for 2019.

### LENTEN STUDY
