2021 - THE YEAR OF HOPE

Synod 2021 - Friday 26-28 February (meeting virtually online)

As we gather to worship this Sunday, Synod 2021 meeting is well underway. Synod is one of the inter-related councils of the Church that form the structure of the Uniting Church in Australia as set out by its Basis of Union. These councils consist of the Congregation, the Church Council, the Presbytery, the Synod and the National Assembly.

Paragraph 15 of the Basis of Union outlines the framework in which these inter-related councils will operate. "The Uniting Church recognises that the responsibility for government in the Church belongs to the people of God by virtue of the gifts and tasks which God has laid upon them. The Uniting Church therefore so organises its life that locally, regionally and nationally, government will be entrusted to representatives, men and women, bearing the gifts and graces with which God has endowed them for the building up of the Church. The Uniting Church is governed by a series of inter-related councils, each of which has its tasks and responsibilities in relation both to the Church and the world."

The Constitution of the Uniting Church defines the role of the Synod as having 'general oversight, direction and administration of the Church's worship, witness and service within its bounds.' Within these defined responsibilities, the Synod, through its Synod Ministries and Operations (SMO), seek to support congregations within its bounds in the following ways. (i) Support and encourage congregations in acts of reconciliation with our Indigenous people; (ii) provide resources and training through Culture of Safety Unit in relation to Child Safe Policies, persons of Concern regulatory requirements; (iii) monitor Occupational Health and Safety protocols, Insurance program providing cover for any personal injury, theft, and property claims; (iv) Property Services to support congregations to ensure facilities are fit for missional purposes, ensuring disability access; (v) Moderator providing pastoral support, through Pastoral letters and visits; (vi) provide education for ministers and lay leaders; (vii) centralised stipend help congregations pay their ministry agents; (viii) Crisis team to support congregation in times of time of crisis, Covid Q&A, bushfire relief, worship resources,; apply and monitor JobKeeper payments on behalf of every congregations, (ix) offer IT support for congregation websites; (x) help resolve disputes and offer pastoral care to minister, members and congregations; (xi) calling a new minister, move the new minister to the manse, look after work-cover, long-service and retirement requirements; (xii) Crosslights and e-news; (xiii) Resourcing Presbytery and congregation through funding of missional projects and oversight.


